SUMMER TAX BILLS:

Howell Township's summer taxes are statutorily due by September 14, 2025, unless deferred. **This year's summer taxes will be accepted without interest through Monday, September 15, 2025, by 5:00 p.m. We do not accept postmarks.** Beginning September 16, 2025, 1% interest will be added, plus 1% per month thereafter. The Township is open Monday-Thursday from 8-5:00p.m., closed Friday and all federal holidays. You can pay your taxes by mail, at the Township Hall, or through our website.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not waive interest, penalties, or administration fees. The legal responsibility of paying taxes on the correct parcel of property rests with the taxpayer. The Treasurer is not responsible for payments made to the wrong parcel, so it is important that you include your property identification and phone number with all payments.

Tax bills paid through your online banking system may take 15 to 20 business days to be received by the Township since they are processed by a third-party vendor. If an escrow company has requested your tax bill it will be indicated on your tax bill after the phrase, "This escrow company requested your bill:" Please be aware that your mortgage company most likely uses a separate escrow company.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

- CREDIT/DEBIT CARD IN PERSON OR ONLINE All credit / debit card payments are subject to a
 processing fee whether they are made online or at the Township Hall. We do not accept credit/debit
 card payments over the phone.
- 2) **CASH** The office keeps minimal cash on hand for security reasons. Please pay with small denomination bills or with the exact change.
- 3) CHECKS Make checks payable to: Howell Township Treasurer. Include your telephone number and property ID number (i.e., 4706-xx-xxx-xxx) on your check. Please write checks for the exact amount of taxes due; do not round up to the next dollar amount. Please use black or blue ink when writing out a check.
- 4) **ONLINE PAYMENTS** You may pay your tax bill online at **howelltownshipmi.org**, follow the link **PAY ONLINE**. Please be aware processing fees apply to all online payments. Howell Township does not accept ECHECK payments through our website.
- 5) **DROP BOX** The Township has a drop box located at the front of the Township Hall by the main entrance for your convenience. Do not leave cash in the drop box. **Any payments left after 5:00 p.m. will be processed on the next Township business day.**
- 6) **PARTIAL PAYMENTS** The Treasurer accepts partial payments for taxes.
- 7) **RECEIPTS** Receipts are given upon request. If you would like a receipt emailed or mailed to you, please indicate so on your tax stub.

* Rabies Vaccination must cover the complete licensing period. You may find that you must purchase one year licenses until your dog becomes eligible			

for a three year license.

Expiration Dates

- Dog License expire when the dog's rabies vaccination expires.
- The County Treasurer's office will send reminder postcards to the licensee 60 days prior to the rabies expiration date. Check your rabies expiration date to see if you need to set up an appointment with your veterinarian.
